

# Core Safety Training

Core Safety Training provides employees with the general information needed to do their job safely and in compliance with UNL policies and regulations. The general safety orientation class is designed to teach employees about their rights and responsibilities pertaining to safety, accident reporting, inspections, safe work practices, and regulatory requirements. *Core Safety Training is required for all UNL employees once during employment.*

Instructor-led classes are offered quarterly (current schedule: <http://ehs.unl.edu/training/>) or you can request training for your department. Training can also be taken over the internet at <http://ehs.unl.edu/onlinetraining/>

Core Safety Training is divided into two parts covering the following:

Part I (For all employees)

- Injury and Illness Prevention Plan
- General Safety Information
- Emergency Response and General Fire Safety

Part II (Employees who work with chemicals)

- Chemical Safety
- Chemical Waste Management
